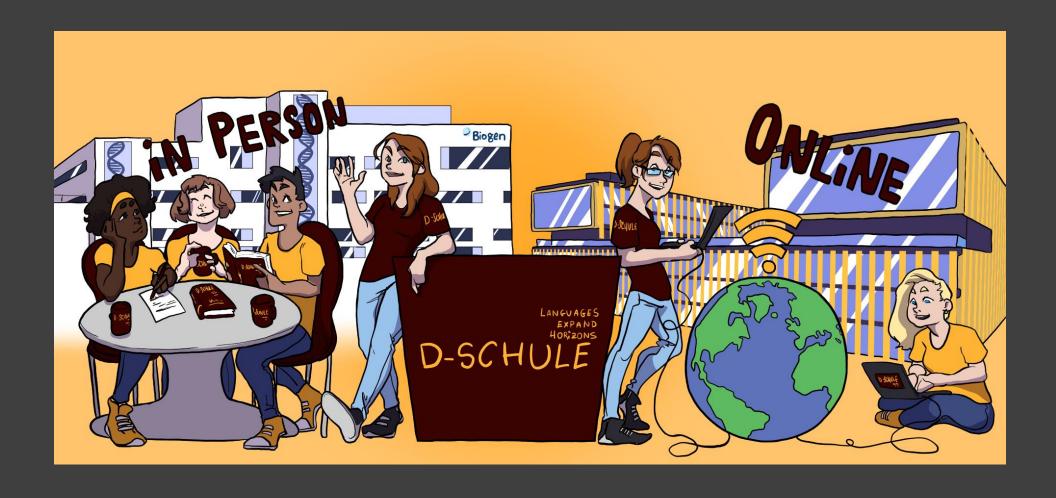

7. Of the four or five aspects of bulk products, top priority is the concentration of reactants of the product itself.

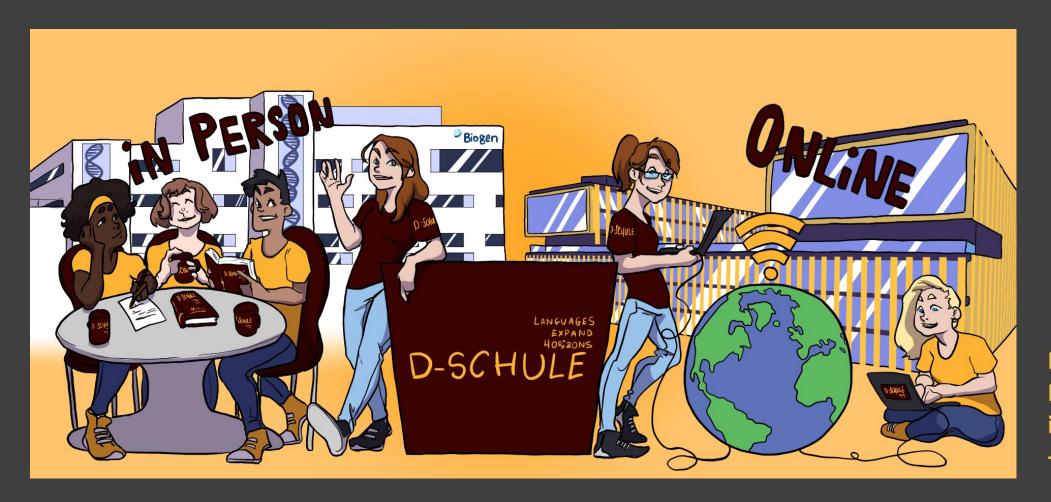
