Program and guidelines for cleaning procedures
The use of non-cleanroom specified cleaning is to be
<u>avoided</u> .
DI water (deionised water) is preferable for
surfaces, , walls, and benches.
The use of scrubs, rags and powder and surfactants in
the cleanroom <u>is prohibited</u> , since these shed
woven polyester, which produce shedding or tearing during cleaning.
The use a moveable autoclave <u>multi-bucket</u> <u>system</u> on non
marring wheels, and deep-drawn seamless buckets, is designated for clean- &/dirty-wate control.
• Floors are to be damp-mopped using distilled* water daily, before
work shifts.
Floors are to be damp-mopped weekly with a clean-room detergent and distilled
, and with a HEPA (high efficiency particulate air) filte
vacuum-cleaner. • Walls are to be vacuumed daily.
 Walls are wiped once, weekly, with a damp clean-room sponge using distilled water.

Windows and clean-room pass-throughs are to be
and dry daily with lint-free 70% IPA wipes.
Ceilings are to be vacuumed daily, wiped with a damp sponge and distilled wate
weekly, before being vacuum-dried. If necessary, ceilings are to be washed with detergent and distilled water to remove any
remains.
All daily except for floors may be performed during
regular work shifts. Overhang light lenses and troffer light fixtures need be wiped with a dam
and distilled water weekly, and then vacuum dried.
Sticky-mats in the cleanroom should be replaced without hesitation, when showing
